2. Non-VA Bills
 - A. In Dublin, contact Fee Services to see if the VA can pay the bill. Call 478-277-2825.

B. Contact the community hospital's finance department for a payment plan.

C. Consider applying for Medicaid. If the bills are from the past 90 days, and if you are eligible for Medicaid, then the program may pay for some of these bills, even if you were not enrolled in Medicaid at the time. Make sure you tell the Case Worker that you have these bills when you apply for Medicaid.
